Title: Proposal of locations of CBCs and the structure of the Committee for CBC's operation

Abstract

We considered locations of Capacity Building Centres (CBCs) from the viewpoint of financial and human support and feasibility of accepting students from developing countries. We think WTU should establish CBCs in developed country.

We also consider the structure of the Committee for CBC's operation. We think WTU should establish the committee for CBC's operation in one place for efficient operation. And we think WTU should give a key position to private companies for enabling their support and internship programs.

Rationale

We think financial and human support by private companies and universities should be considered in selecting CBC locations because WTU cannot provide sufficient financial support and human resources to establish and operate CBCs. Private companies and universities in developed country can provide them. In addition, they can provide facilities for training programs.

We think feasibility of accepting students from developing countries should also be considered. Developed countries in Europe have strong relations with African counties and have accepted students from Africa. United States has also accepted students from developing countries all over the world. Therefore we think it is feasible that CBCs in Europe and United States accept students.

We think establishment of the Committee for CBC's operation in one place makes operation of CBCs efficient. This enables to avoid overlap of training programs between CBCs. In addition, this enables the Committee to control qualities of programs of all CBCs and equalize them.

We think giving a key position to private companies is necessary for strong connection between CBCs and private companies. This will realize financial and human support from private companies and training programs including internship.

Proposal

- WTU should establish 2 CBCs in developed country. One should be in Europe, and the other should be in United States.

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- WTU should establish the Committee for CBC's operation in one place.
 - The committee should have 1 Head, 2 Deputy Head, 1 Secretary General:
 - Head: WTU member from developed country
 - Deputy Head: WTU member from developing country and person from an association of private IT companies
 - Secretary General: WTU member from developed country.
 - The Committee should have a guideline that the association of private IT companies shall provide staffs for training programs and accept internships.
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
