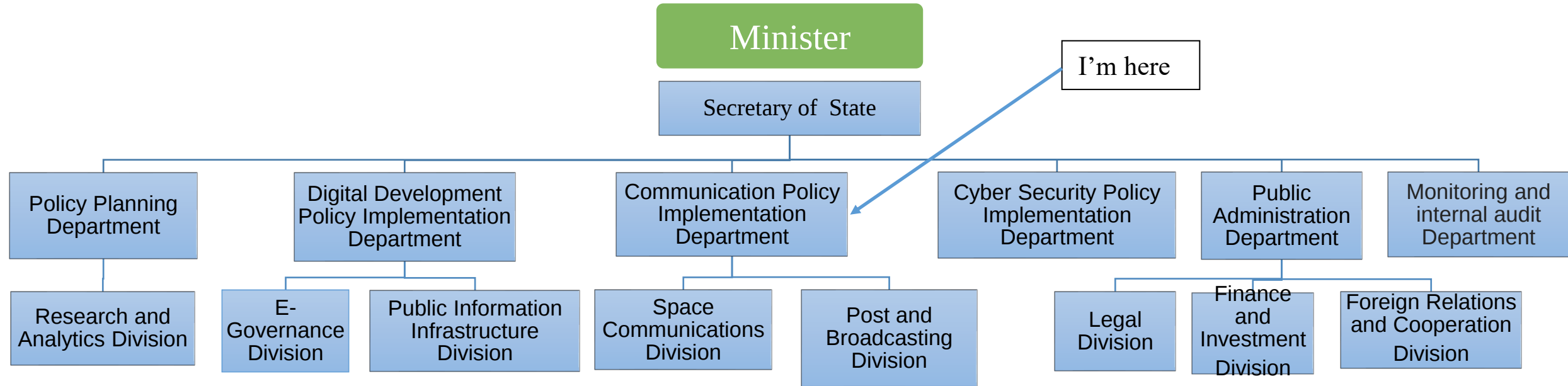

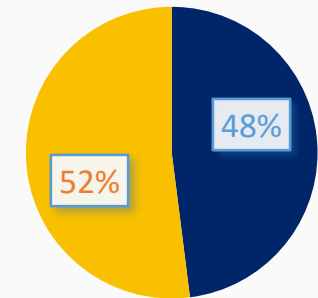

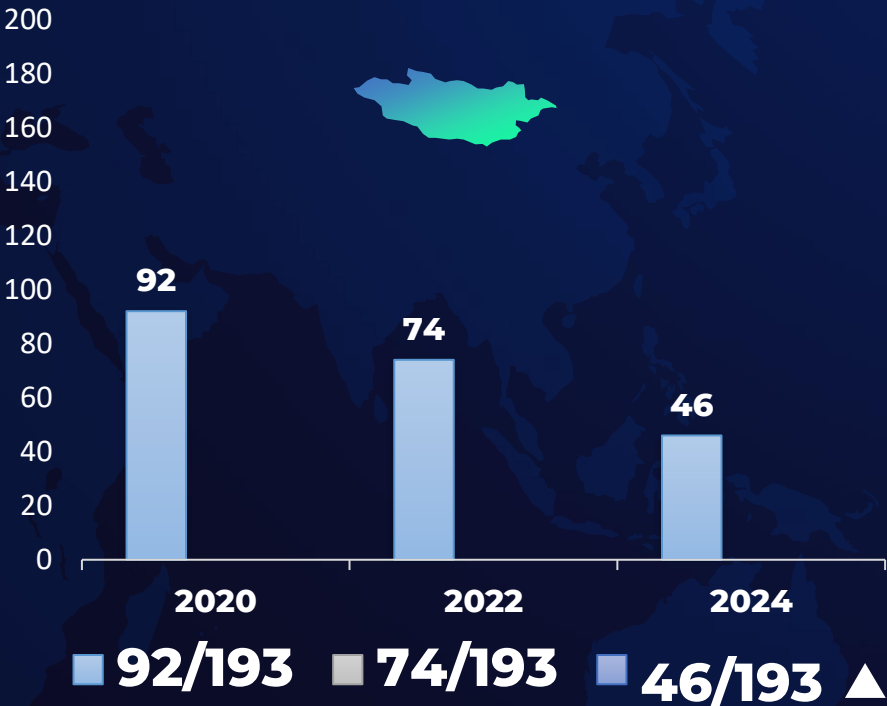

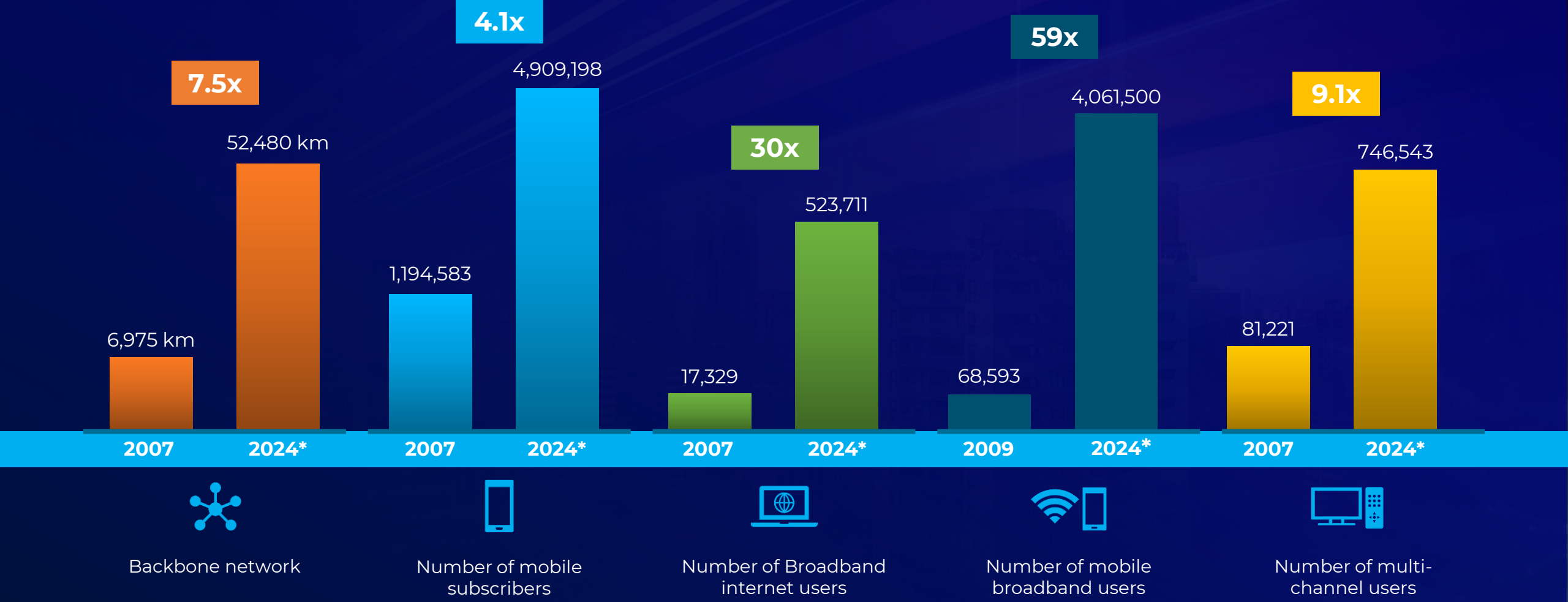

ICT sectoral overview

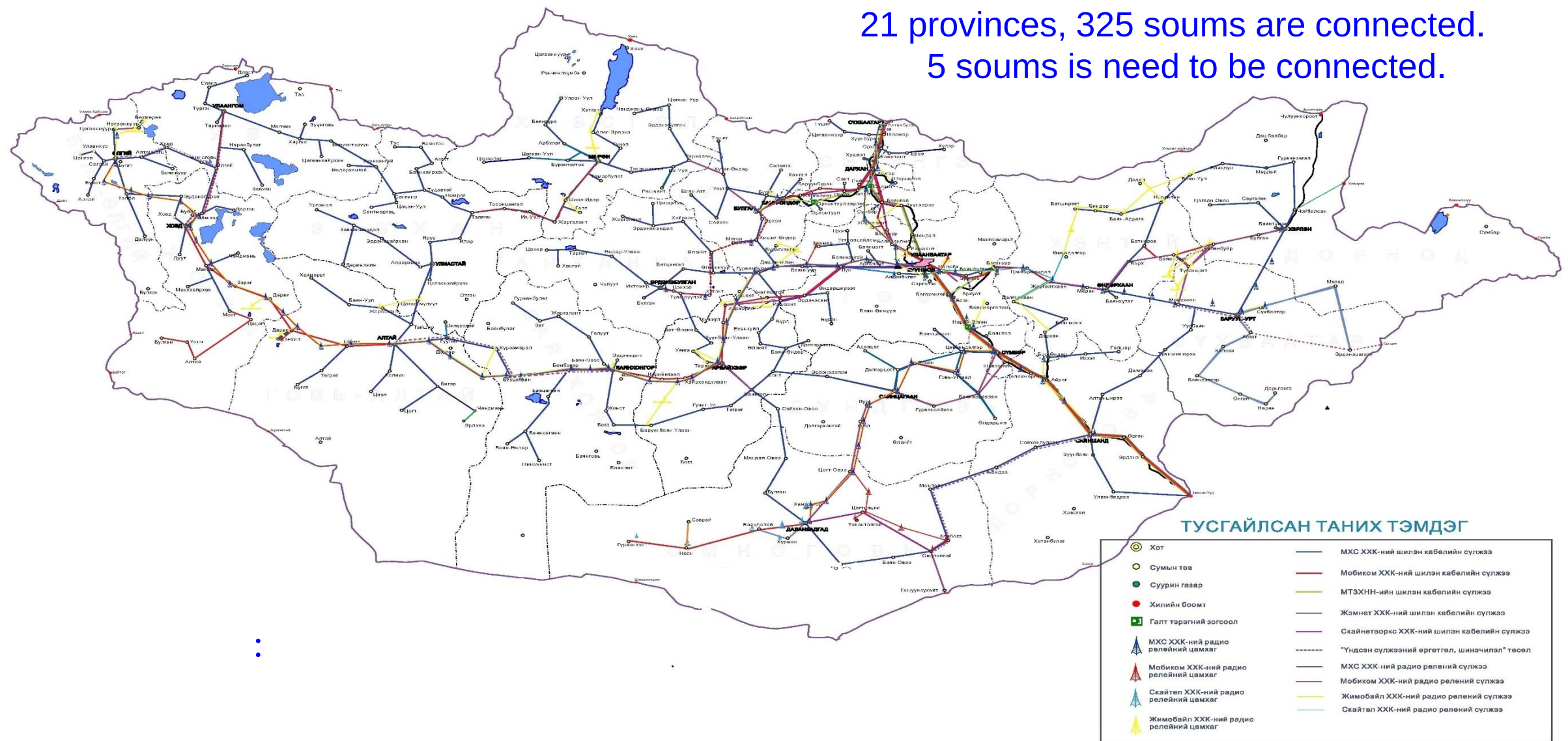
Comparison of numerical indicators of ICT industry development (2007 vs 2024)

Fiber optic communication network

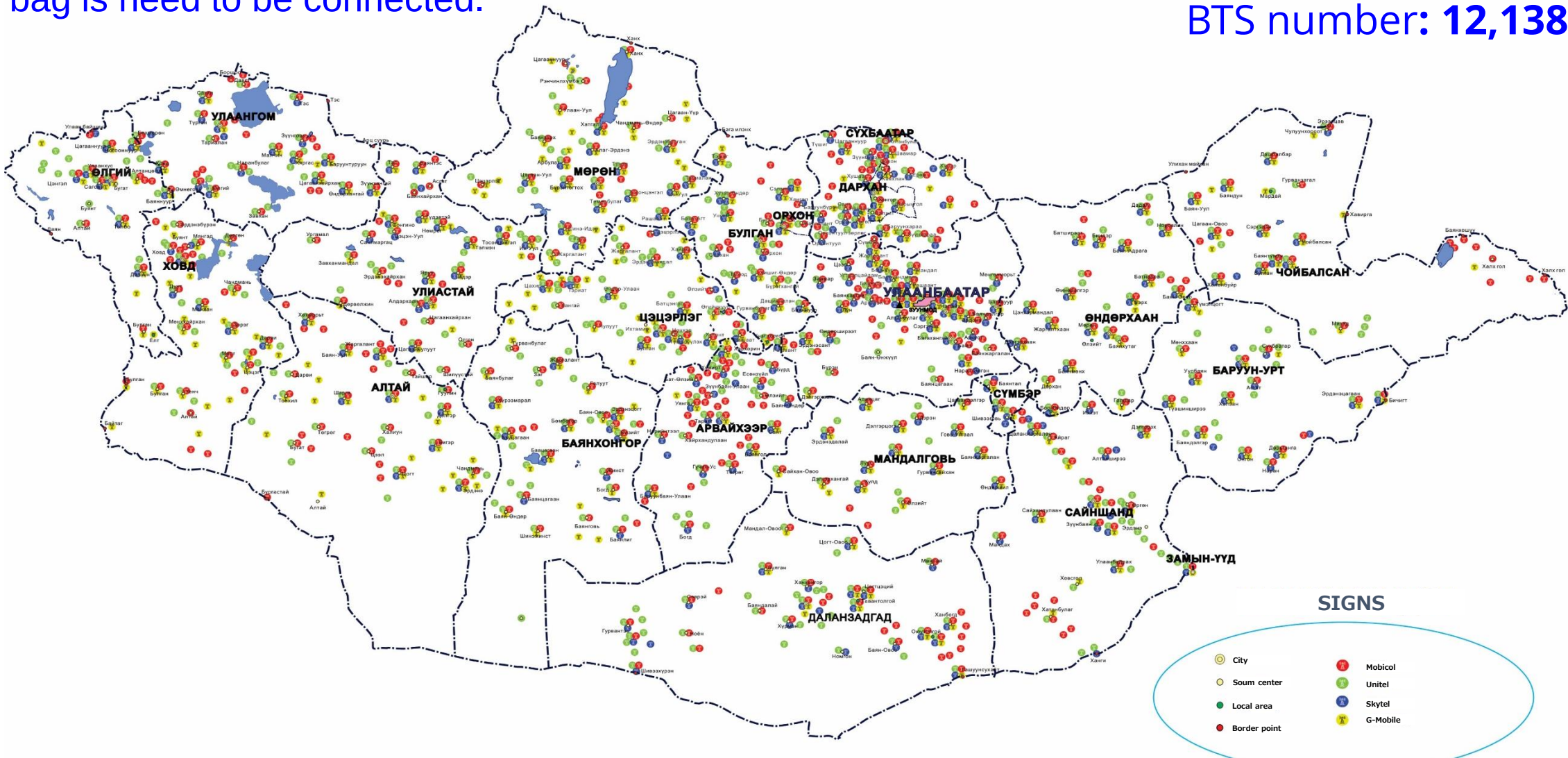
21 provinces, 325 soums are connected.

Coverage of mobile network

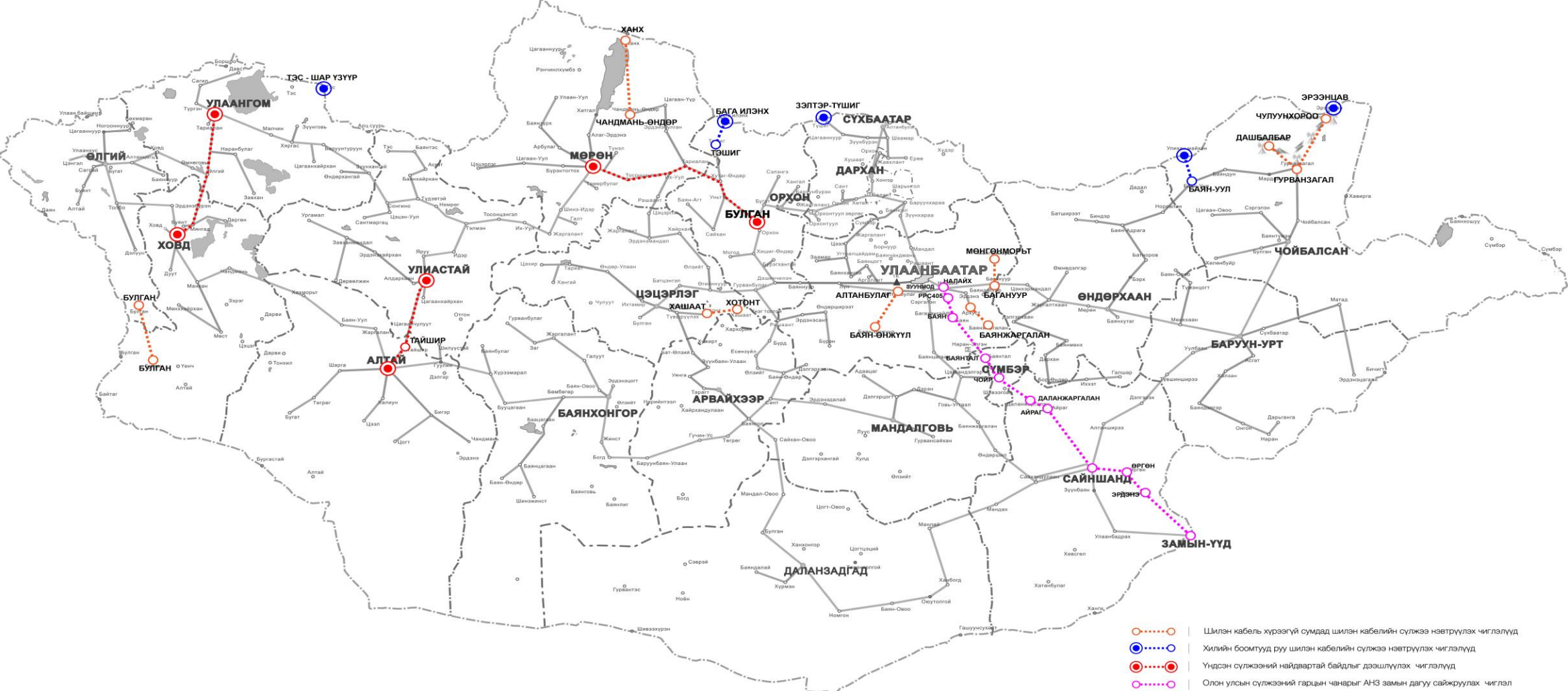
Mobile coverage reaches 20-100% of 1448 bag from 1639 bag in total.

BTS number: **12,138**



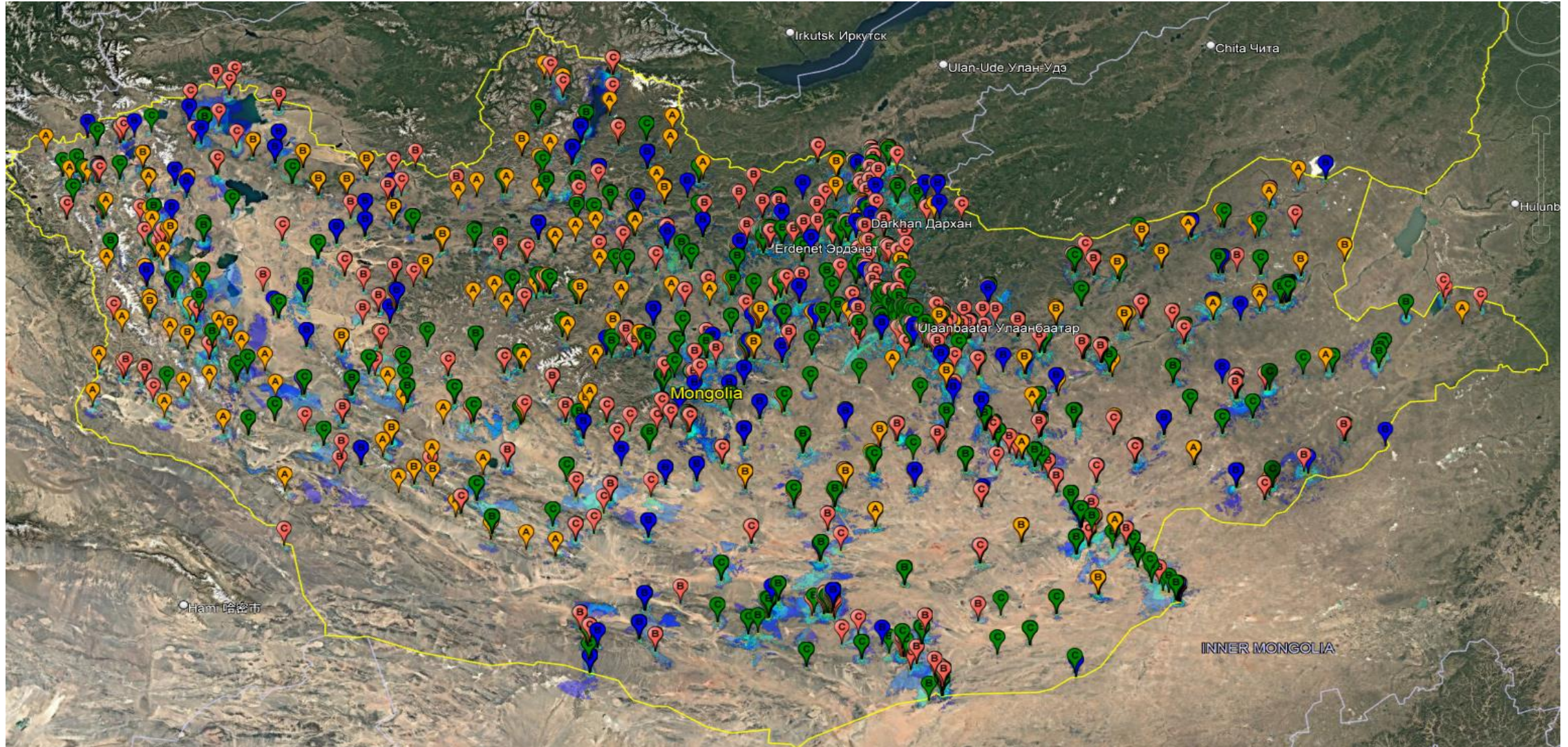
